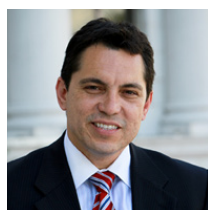


Research Briefing: “What about the Schools? – Factors Contributing to Expanded State Investment in School Facilities”
