**State 49%**

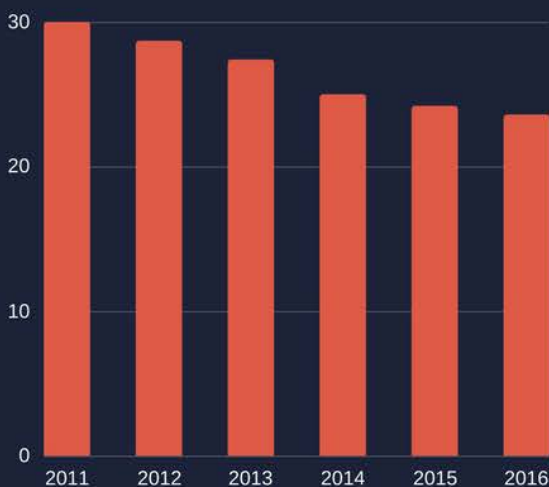
**51% Local**
