Texas Quick Facts:

- **88.9%** of emergent bilingual students are Spanish-speakers
- There are over **70** different home languages spoken by Texas emergent bilingual students.
- The percentage of emergent bilingual students has grown by **31.8%** over the last 10 years.

Bilingual Education Bills that Advance Dual Language Programs

HB 2258 (Guerra) / SB 560 (Lucio)

Creates a state **strategic** plan for bilingual education that promotes high quality dual language immersion programs

HB 2256 (Guerra) / SB 1101 (Creighton)

Creates a bilingual special education certificate to meet the needs of **all** students.

HB 1744 (Guerra)

Reduces programmatic barriers for educators and pre-service teachers to **access** bilingual education certification programs and support robust dual language immersion program implementation across the state.

HB 4421 (Meza) / SB 2125 (Blanco)

Sets goals for student achievement in **both** languages for students enrolled in dual language immersion programs.

Over 1 million emergent bilingual students are currently enrolled in Texas public schools.




Texas educates the highest percentage of emergent bilinguals in the United States,

- This is about **15% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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
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House District 121

- That is **25,119** total emergent bilingual students in House District 121.

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

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

- That is **74,367** total emergent bilingual students in House District 123.

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

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- That is 6,501 total emergent bilingual students in House District 54.

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


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House District 142

- This is about **10% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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
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House District 75

- This is about **12% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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
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House District 41

- This is about **18% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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
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House District 127

- This is about **7% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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

- That is 6,347 total emergent bilingual students in House District 88.

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
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House District 43

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

- This is about **20% higher** than the state average of 20% emergent bilingual students.

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
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House District 52

- That is **19,143** total emergent bilingual students in House District 52.

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
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House District 1
