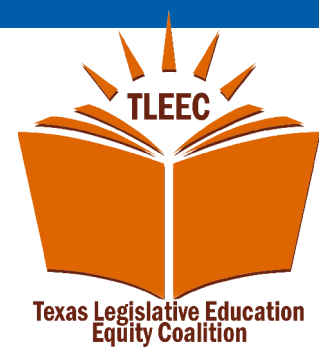


# TLEEC Policy Agenda – Texas Legislative Session 2023 – Third Special Session

### Protect and increase funding for schools:

- Address the teacher shortage by increasing the basic allotment.
- Guard against voucher systems to keep public money in public schools.



### Support high-quality public school programs for bilingual education, special education and college access

- Provide educator and student support for bilingual and special education in training, materials and classroom management techniques that keep students in school.
- Promote ethnic studies courses and college-preparatory classes in high school that prepare students for college success.
