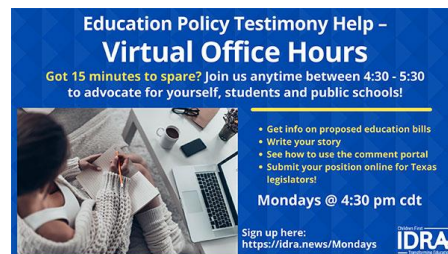
Submit Your Comments this Week
